Dear Cumberland Resident,

As we prepare for opening the residence halls, we needed to make changes in order to adhere to the guidelines set by the Rhode Island Department of Health and the CDC. Specifically, we need to have designated space in campus housing for the purpose of quarantine and isolation. We regret to inform you that Cumberland House has been selected as quarantine and isolation housing.

We have the following options available to you:

Option 1 - Move to a 2 or 4 person suite in the Suite Village

Option 2 - Move to a suite in Barrington House

Option 3 - Move to a vacant space in housing

Option 4 - Move to a double room at a local hotel (you must have your own transportation for this option)

Please complete the [Cumberland Relocation Preference Form](#) to indicate your preferred options by **Friday, July 24th**. While we will try to accommodate preferences, we cannot guarantee that you will be placed in your first choice.

We understand that a change in plans is difficult and disappointing. Due to the unforeseen circumstances, if you choose to relocate and remain in campus housing, you will receive a one-time credit of \$300 for the Fall semester to your student account. This credit will be processed on your account by August 7th. If you are no longer interested in living on campus, please complete the [housing withdrawal form](#) to be released from housing.
